## Before



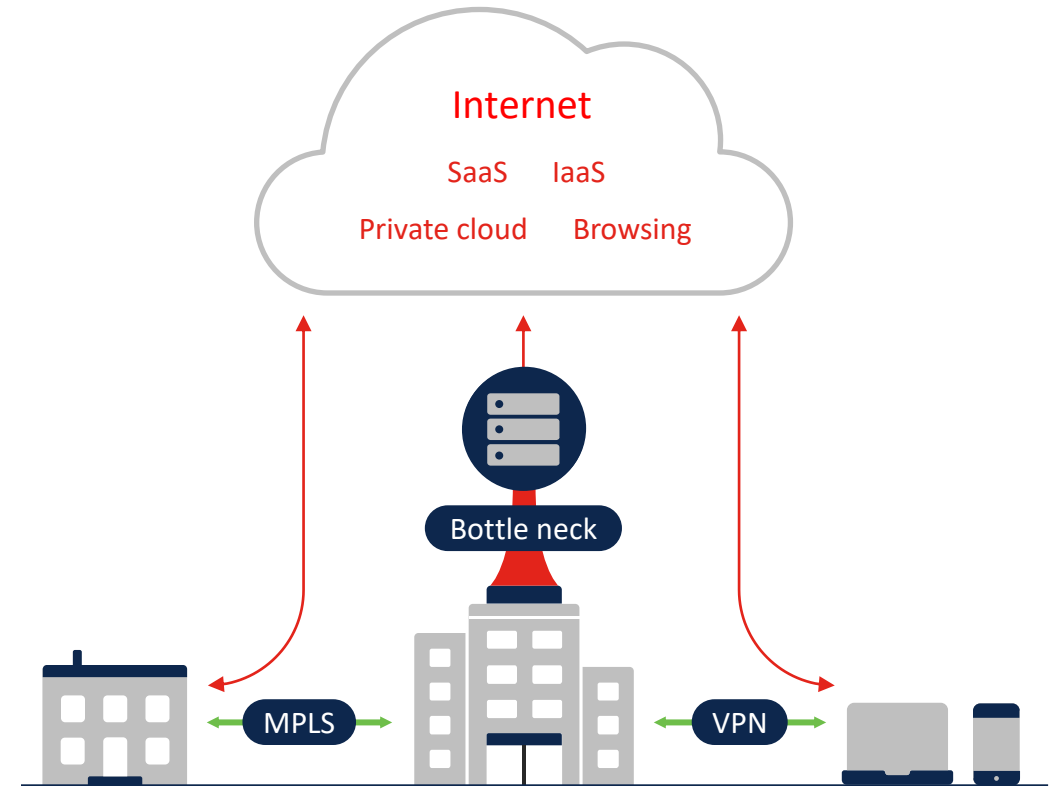
Apps: Hosted in datacenter

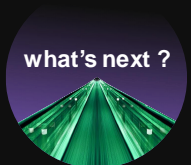

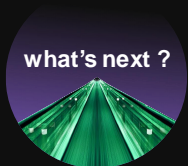
